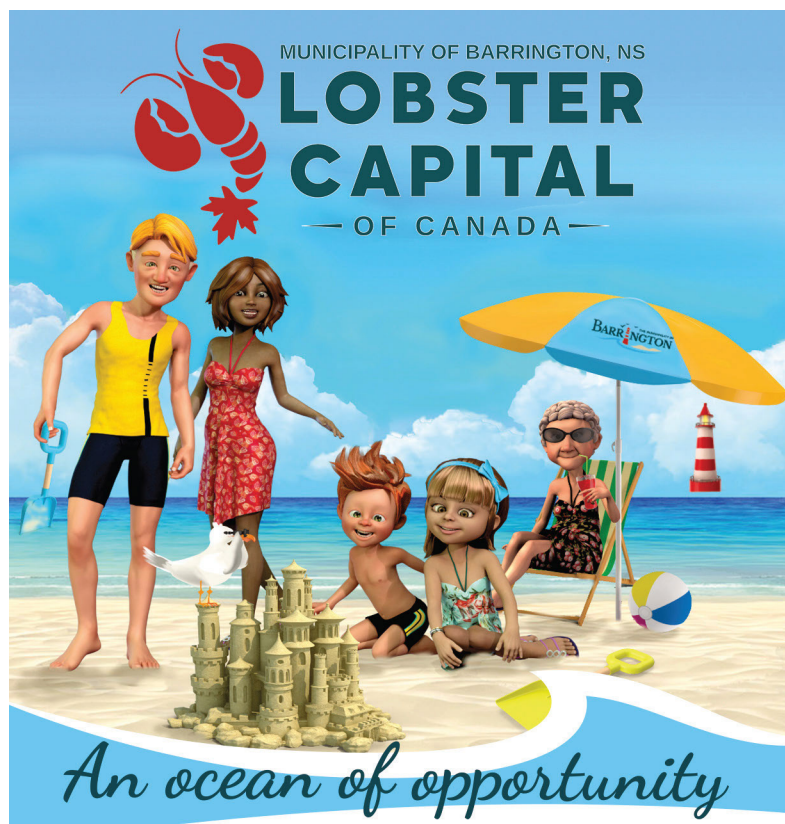

## DID YOU KNOW?

We are the **Lobster Capital of Canada** - over 23,000 tonnes of Lobsters are landed in south western Nova Scotia each year, accounting for over 40% of Canada's catch and 23% of all lobsters caught in North America.

We are home to the **first government recognized UFO sighting in the World** - learn about the 1967 Shag Harbour UFO sighting at the UFO Interpretive Centre in Shag Harbour.



The most **southerly point** of (mainland) Nova Scotia is located on Cape Sable Island in the tiny community known as The Hawk.

We are home to the **tallest lighthouse** in the Maritimes - Cape Sable Lighthouse - standing at 101 feet tall.

We are home to a **drowned forest** - visible only at low tide, this ancient forest is thought to be over 1500 years old. Located on the Hawk, Cape Sable Island.

We are home to the **oldest non-conformist house of worship in Canada** - The Old Meeting House Museum, built in 1782.

We are one of the **best birding destinations** in Eastern Canada and home to 4 Important Bird Areas.



The famous **Cape Island boat** was designed and built on Cape Sable Island, known locally as the Cape Islander, you will find them at every wharf in the Municipality.

We have **6 beautiful white sand beaches** located throughout the Municipality.

In December we construct a **giant Christmas Tree** built from lobster traps and decorated with buoys to honour local and past fishermen and those lost at sea. (Festival of Lights - held annually in December)

We are home to Lucy the Lobster, the only prognosticating crustacean in the world! Watch her prediction each February 2nd as she helps to kick off the Nova Scotia Lobster Crawl.

## GETTING HERE

Arrive by Land

Take Highway 103 from Halifax and head west via the South Shore.

Follow the scenic Route #3 south from Halifax along the South Shore.

Take Highway 101 from Halifax and head west via the Annapolis Valley.

Arrive by Air

Stanfield International Airport in Halifax, Nova Scotia welcomes many international flights daily. We are a short 2.5 hour drive from the airport. There are daily flights from other provinces in Canada, the USA and Europe. Visit them online at flyhalifax.com.

Arrive by Sea

Drive on with your vehicle or walk on board any of the Bay Ferries locations.

- Coming from Bar Harbor, Maine to Yarmouth, we are a short 45 minute drive from the terminal.
- Arrive from Saint John, New Brunswick into the port of Digby, NS. We are a two hour drive from Digby.

Arrive from Prince Edward Island to New Glasgow, a four hour drive to the Municipality of Barrington.
